Dear Resident,

This is an invitation to join the Stopit campaign to oppose the plans by Manor Farm and Earsham Gravel for gravel extraction and waste recycling in Haddiscoe. A committee was formed as a result of two public meetings at Haddiscoe Village hall. We have co-opted Martin Mears (Solicitor Old Rectory Haddiscoe) to act for us and we agreed that we will need a fund to employ expert witnesses to rebut any Environmental Impact Assessment produced by the other side should these proposals come to a planning application which could happen very soon. We also agreed that we should have a committed membership so that we can be certain who we are representing when it comes to official action.

We have an initial target of £5000 to raise.

So we propose a **membership fee of £10 per household**, this is set deliberately low so as to encourage as wide a participation as possible, however it is obvious this will not cover costs, bearing in mind that there are less than 200 houses in the village. Therefore, as well as membership we are asking for voluntary donations.

The money will only be used for the purposes of this campaign and any money not spent will be returned to contributors on a pro rata basis at the end of the campaign.
